In 1522, his expedition was the first to circumnavigate the globe and the first to navigate the strait in South America connecting the Atlantic and Pacific oceans. This wine is a homage to this brave man.

Brilliant violet-red color. Aromatic and fruity nose that reminds of plums, black cherries and raspberries combined with floral aromas of wild violets and spices. Silky long tannins, with a balanced acidity and a lingering finish.

Ideal with empanadas, grilled meats, barbecued goat, pasta with intense sauces and bird game.
