Fernando de Magallanes was a Portuguese-born maritime explorer who, at the service of Spain, attempted to find a westward route to the Spice Islands of Indonesia. In 1522, his expedition was the first to circumnavigate the globe and the first to navigate the strait in South America connecting the Atlantic and Pacific oceans. This wine is homage to this brave man.

A sweet wine with a full fruit taste and a clean finish. Bright and crystalline; light yellow, with the floral and citric bouquet characteristic of the area.

Its soft fruits and delicate aroma reminds to peaches and pineapples. In the mouth it presents a nice acidity and a long ending.

Ideal to be drunk alone or for matching pasta, rice and all kind of fish and seafood, as well as with fruit desserts, blue and semi soft cheeses and dry fruits. A true all-occasion wine. Serve cold, at 8-10° C.
