Ar is also the diminutive for Argentina: land of great wines and great contrasts.
Tamarí Ar is a wine with deep red colour, high aroma concentration and a long aftertaste, obtained by a selection of the best berries.

Pour or decant slowly as this wine may have natural deposits resulting from ageing.
