#### CENTRAL VALLEY

Created in the 1940's, Viña Santa Helena is backed by sixty years in the winemaking business. Santa Helena wines are bought all over the world, confirming their exceptional quality. This grape was once heavily planted in Bordeaux and is one of the six varieties allowed in red wines from that region. Carmenère is now almost impossible to find in Bordeaux after the Phylloxera blight in 1867. Today, it is most used in Chile where it was imported in 1850.

A young wine, with red fruit aromas and herbal notes. This is a wine with medium persistence and a smooth ripe fruit flavor, ideal for enjoyment on any occasion.
