

SAUVIGNON BLANC 2009

The 2009 vintage is sourced from two valleys: 85% of the blend comes from Casablanca Valley and the remaining 15% is sourced from two different blocks in Leyda Valley. This wine displays a brilliant yellow colour with greenish hues aromas of tropical fruits and tangerines together with a hint of minerals and toasted bread. The mouth is rich, with flavours of white necturities, green pineapples and a lemongrass finish. All of its flavours are richly expressed, from its notes of tropical fruits to its mineral hint in the flinkh, in addition to its great natural acidity.

SAUVIGNON BLANC 2010

This Sauvignon Blanc is sourced from the Leyda Valley of Chile only 7 kilometres from the Pacific coast. This wine is characterized by its pungent herbal flavours and mineral notes and great natural acking displays a bright yellow colour with greenish hues, aromas of pink grapefruit, bell pepper, with yeasy and gun powder notes. The mouth is rich with white nectation, green pepper and lemon grass finish. The wine has length and richness on the palate with a lingering mineral finish.

D.O. VALLE DE LEYDA

SAUVIGNON BLANC 2011

This Sauvignon Blanc is sourced from the Leyda Valley of Chile only 7 kilometres from the Pacific coast. This wine is characterized by its pungent berbal flavours and mineral notes and great natural activity displays a bright yellow colour with greenish hues, aromas of pink grapefruit. bell pepper, with yearsy and gun powder notes. The mouth is rich with white nectarian green pepper and lemon grass finish. The wine has length and richness on the palate with a lingering mineral linish.
