We invite you to discover and enjoy the characteristics of each of the wines in the Chilean Cabernet Sauvignon series. This is Chile's emblematic variety grown in a richly diverse viticultural paradise.

Alta Helena consists of a series of 4 Cabernet Sauvignon from Chile's most prestigious wine valleys. All of the vineyards are located in the highest zones closest to the Andes Mountains in order to receive the influence of its cool night temperatures.

Alta Helena was designed to provide the opportunity to discover Chilean Cabernet Sauvignon in wines made with the same style and philosophy, with just one variable factor: their valley of origin.

Common characteristics in these wines:

100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the same vintage grown on ungrafted, phylloxera-free vines from massal selections planted in high-altitude single vineyards. The grapes undergo the same vinification process and all 4 wines are aged in oak barrels for 14 months.

Discover and enjoy the differences between the wines from the Aconcagua, Maipo, Colchagua, and Curicó Valleys.
