

PINOT NOIR 2012

2012 is the first vintage of Gran Reserva Tarapaca Pinot Noir. This wine is a blend of different vineyards in the cool coastal valleys of Chile. The Chequeque vineyard is tucked in the Coastal mountains of the Leyda coast, a warmer site. Its contribution is plummy flavors and honey notes with salty tannins. Hillside Canelo block contributes with an elegant Pinot Noir with lighter color with sour cherry and floral notes and crisp acidity. The Araña Vineyard is a classic Pinot Noir bring cherry and raspberry spice and nervous tannins was held in stainless steel to preserve typicity. It will age nicely for, at least, ten years.

PINOT NOIR 2013

Pinot Noir Gran Reserva is a blend of 3 different vineyards of Leyda Valley, a cool coastal region.

The first lot is a warmer site and provide plummy flavours and honey notes, with salty tannins to the blend.

Other block contributes with an elegant Pinot Noir, with lighter colour, sour cherry, floral notes and crisp acidity. Last vineyard gives a classic Pinot Noir, with cherry, raspberry and spicy notes. It will age nicely for, at least, ten years.
