The coastal Leyda Valley was planted as recently as 1998, but already one can sense its enormous potential for sauvignon blanc, chardonnay and pinot noir. Just eight miles from the chilly waters of the Pacific Ocean, Leyda's cool climate is more maritime than Casablanca with an even lower average temperature, less frost risk and a maximum average temperature in the hottest month of just 25°C. The vineyards are planted on rolling hills, with poor clay soils, low in organic matter, which are ideal for producing small yields of concentrated grapes. We are delighted to have worked with Viña Leyda and their talented winemaker Viviana Navarrete to produce this pinot noir. It has intense aromas of black cherries, and a hint of vanilla from partial maturation in oak e silky palate.
