

RED BLEND 2012

Tarapacá Gran Reserva Etiqueta Azul is the top wine in our Gran Reserva range: a perfect blend made from our best lots in the Maipo Valley. This wine is only produced in extraordinary years and only the best grapes from the finest *terroirs* are selected. Our 2012 is made up of Cabernet Franc (43%), Cabernet Sauvignon (36%) and Syrah. The Cabernet Franc is sourced from two hillside vineyards in Alto Maipo, where the loam clay soils produce wines with smooth tannins, ripe plum notes and touches of red pepper spice. Our Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from two vineyards, one in Alto Buin and the other on our estate in Isla de Maipo, where our twenty-year-old Mirador Block, produces elegant Cabernet Sauvignon, bursting with wild berry flavours. Syrah, from our estate vineyards on the cooler riverbanks, makes up the final 21% of the blend. We recommend you decant this expressive, complex wine before enjoying.

RED BLEND 2013

Gran Reserva Tarapacá Blue Label is the most prestigious of the Gran Reserva range. The 2013 blend consists of 54% Cabernet Sauvignon, which provides touches of cherry, blackberry and blackcurrant on the palate, with round tannins produced by the angular rock and gravel-rich soils. The vineyard which gives rise to the Syrah (20%) is located near to the Maipo River, whose cool waters and fresh winds that are brought by the Pacific Ocean in the summer evenings, lend the wine hints of black fruit like blackberry and black cherry, floral notes such as violet and spiced touches that include white pepper, as well as a subtle bouquet of black olive. Finally, the Petit Verdot (16%) and Cabernet Franc (10%), which come from the vineyards on the slopes of the main estate that are composed mainly of loamy 'gravosa' soil and high quality clay, are used to produce full-bodied, unctuous and lengthy wines with a perfect ripeness. The blend was aged for 16 months in French oak.

RED BLEND 2014

Gran Reserva Etiqueta Azul is the icon of Tarapacá's Gran Reserva range. The 2014 vintage is a Red Blend consisting of five grape varieties with distinct characteristics. Cabernet Sauvignon (65%) provides freshness and red fruit notes of raspberry and cherry. The Petit Verdot (14%) vineyard is set on a slope with gravel soils and high quality clay, giving volume and length on the palate. Syrah (11%) adds darker fruit, subtle black olive and floral violet aromas. Finally, Cabernet Franc (5%) and Malbec (5%) complement the blend perfectly, contributing to volume and ripeness. This aromatic wine has excellent structure and balance with a long finish.
