<p><i>Like a tree, deeply rooted in the Chilean viticulture since 1874, arises Viña Tarapacá. In order to honor the roots of its name, which in Quechua, the language of the Chilean northern natives corresponds to "Tara-Pakay" or "Hidden Tree", this limited production wine is born, made with the finest selected grapes stemming from our vineyard in the terroir of Isla de Maipo, a privileged origin in Chile for Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah.</i></p> <p><i>Outstanding maraschino cherry, blue and briary berry notes, along lots of spices such as cinnamon and nutmeg. These aromas interlace well with the smoked, toasted and vanilla notes, which follow with more complex touches to cigar box, forest floor, black pepper and dark bitter chocolate, creating an enveloping volume, with ripe, solid tannins which explode in the mouth and lend to a sweet, delicious, and long finish.</i></p>
