Each of the wines from the 1865 line comes from its own selected vineyard planted with a specific variety. Each "single vineyard" is carefully managed in accordance with the conditions of its grape variety, soil and climate—or terroir—to produce wines with consistently unique personalities and quality. 1865 Malbec comes from Las Lomas, our vineyard located in the Maule Valley. The vineyards were planted 15 years ago with a selection of old vine material. The Mediterranean climate features a broad differential between daytime and night time temperatures, and the poor, rocky soils of granitic origin naturally control plant vigor and produce crop loads of 6 tons per hectare. The result is an expressive Malbec with aromas of blackberries, black currants and other black fruits, along with juicy and concentrated tannins. This wine is bottled unfiltered to preserve all its qualities.
