WINE OF CHILE



Leyda Valley is a unique area in Chile located only 7 km from the Pacific Ocean. Due to the maritime influence, the coastal climate conditions with spring and summer breezes make it an extraordinary cool area for the development of Pinot Noir. All vineyards are on slopes, planted on very poor soils, with calcium carbonate spots and managed in order to keep low yields. The ripening period happens at a slower pace, obtaining the best development of aromas and fruity flavors, along with a balance of a fresh acidity and soft tannins of the ageing in barrels of French oak.
