

CHARDONNAY 2009

The 2009 vintage continues its transition from the warmer Maipo Valley to the cooler coastal region of Leyda Valley. The 2009 wine is a blend made of grapes from the rather cool climate of the region of Alto Maipo and from the coastal region of Leyda. This wine displays a yellow colour with green hues; floral aromas, notes of white peach, along with notes of minerals, yeast and toasted cedar. It's elegant, with great natural acidity, rich in mouth-filling flavours.

Chardonnay Gran Reserva is sourced from vineyards in the coastal Leyda region and is hand picked in the middle of April. The characteristics of this renowned valley provide natural acidity and elegant mineral character to the wine. This unique Chardonnay was barrel fermented then aged with its lees to add richness and complexity. Floral nectarine and apricot aromas along with flinty toasty marzipan notes; white peach and tropical elegant flavors with a rich and sweet creamy mouth long finish.
