The Leyda Valley was only planted in 1998, but already one can sense its enormous potential for sauvignon blanc. Just eight miles from the chilly waters of the Pacific Ocean, Leyda's cool climate is more maritime than Casablanca's with an even lower average temperature, less frost risk and a maximum average monthly temperature of about 25°C. The vineyards are planted on rolling hills, with granitic soils of low fertility, which are ideal for producing small yields of concentrated grapes.

This intensely aromatic sauvignon blanc, redolent of gooseberries and blackcurrant leaves, with a crisp and zesty palate.
