Cabernet Sauvignon - Merlot

Harmonia axyridis is the scientific name of a type of lady beetle, commonly used in organic agriculture as a natural, biological mean of pest control. Thus, she gives the name to this wine of superior quality produced from organically grown grapes in the Cachapoal Valley. Located in the foothills of the Andes Mountains, a clean, pure, and isolated area, these vineyards are the first to use the pure, crystalline waters from the eternally snow-capped mountains.

Both the winegrowing and winemaking processes are certified by the German ISO 65-accredited BCS Öko Garantie organization.

COLOR: Very deep ruby red

AROMA: Intense, fruit-forward nose with fresh blackberry notes. This is a wine with very ripe, juicy aromas and great depth.

PALATE: Elegant, distinguished, and medium-bodied with soft, ripe, delicate tannins and a light touch of wood from its fermentation in French oak vats. This is a well-balanced wine with a nice, long, elegant finish.
