AGED DURING TWELVE MONTHS IN FRENCH AND AMERICAN OAK BARRELS.

ITS FLAVOURS ARE PRIMARILY OF VERY RIPE BERRIES, WITH AN
UNDERLYING SPICY CHARACTER, ADDING DEPTH AND COMPLEXITY. FULL
ROUND BODY AND MEDIUM INTENSITY MAKE IT PERFECT FOR
RED MEATS AND SPICY DISHES. UNCORK ONE HOUR BEFORE DRINKING AND
SERVE AT ROOM TEMPERATURE (18°C).
